1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned AGA for the State.
2. The present 482 Cr.P.C. application has been filed to quash the the entire proceedings of Complaint Case No.1231 of 2021 "Eco Mitra Associates Vs. Shyam Herbal Care" as well as summoning order dated 18.08.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, Court No.-4, Allahabad, under Section-406 I.P.C., Police Station-Civil Lines, District-Prayagraj.
3. Contention of learned counsel for the applicant is that opposite party no.2 and applicant were having business relationship regarding supply of medicines. During course of business transaction, the dispute arose and present proceeding has been initiated by opposite party no.2 just to give criminal colour to the business transaction.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party no.2 returnable at an early date.
6. Steps be taken within a week.
7. List on 18.09.2023.
8. Till the next date of listing, proceeding of Complaint

Case No.1231 of 2021 "Eco Mitra Associates Vs. Shyam Herbal Care as well as summoning order dated 18.08.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, Court No.-4, Allahabad, under Section-406 I.P.C., Police Station-Civil Lines, District-Prayagraj, shall remain stayed, against the applicant.

This Court finds from perusal of several petitions that Stamp Reporting Section of this Court has cleared all the Application u/s 482 Cr.P.C., Criminal Revision, Matters Under Article 227 of the Constitution of India as well as Criminal Misc. Bail Application etc. without looking to the fact that in the affidavit filed in support of the application full description of parties are not being mentioned which causes great inconvenience to the Court while dictating the judgement/order.

10. Therefore, Stamp Reporting Section of this Court is directed to clear those petitions/applications in which full description of parties were given in affidavit filed in support of all applications/petitions.
